What We Are Learning

- Math: This week we will finishing up Topic 4 working on 2-digit by 2-digit equations, with a test on Friday 12/11. Please work with your child at home as well on their multiplication facts.
- Science: This week we will continue working on our current chapter on Plants and Animals within our Life Science unit. We will continue working on the life cycle of Florida animals through complete and incomplete metamorphosis.
- Social Studies: This week we will be learning about world geography and the different holiday celebrations that are celebrated around the world.
- Reading: This week we be reading "Pecos Bill" will focus on determining themes, analyzing dialogue and figurative language and analyzing characters and their actions.
